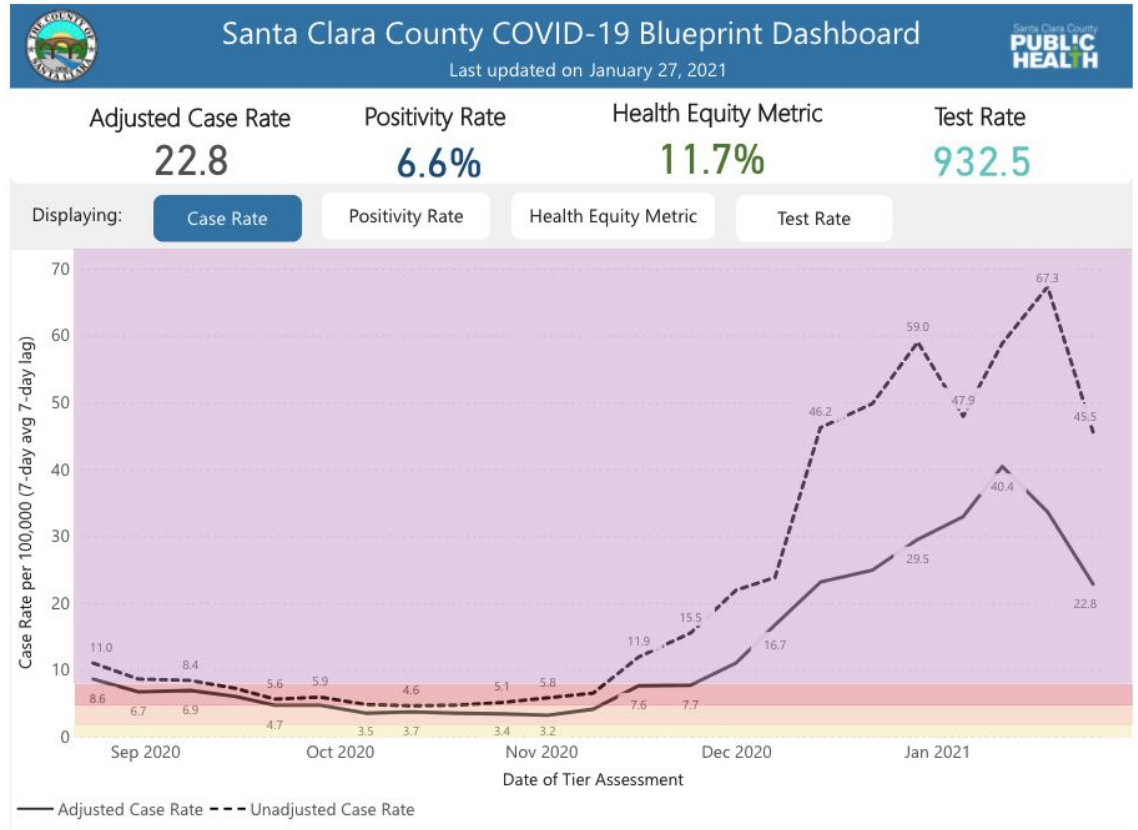
Current Status

1. Governor lifts stay at home order Jan. 26, 2021
Our county and most of Calif. still in Purple (Widespread) Tier
 2. Governor's proposed plan is going through legislative process - Feb 1 timeline will not be upheld - other changes anticipated
 3. Calif. Dept. of Public Health (CDPH) released New Framework with consolidated guidance for in-person instruction
 4. CUSD updated School Reopening Plan
 5. Employee COVID-19 testing, tracking & tracing continues

State-level Updates

Cal. Dept. of Public Health (1/14/21)

- Consolidates/Clarifies directives from State offices for schools to open for in-person learning
- CUSD phased-in Reopening Plan updated to reflect new requirements and clarifications
 - Existing plan already addressed the goals of state and local public health officials

Governor (12/30/20- Present) Proposal stalled in legislation

- New CDPH guidance altered some of Newsom's plan details
 - Waiting for Legislative action re: funds and support for reopening requirements
 - COVID-19 vaccination eligibility
 - Current guidelines: healthcare personnel, long-term care facility residents in Phase 1A, and County residents age 65 and older.
 - Anticipated update on educators in mid February

New CDPH Reopening Framework, Guidance & Requirements

1. Complete and post a COVID-19 Safety Plan:

a. CAL/OSHA Prevention Program Plan

- i. Incorporated into Injury Intervention Prevention Plan (IIPP)
- ii. Update provided to all employees 1/13/21

b. COVID-19 School Guidance Checklist

- i. Incorporated into update of CUSD Reopening Plan
- ii. Superintendent's Parent Advisory Committee input (1/29)
- iii. Reopening Committee input (postponed from 1/27, set for 2/11)

2. Provide county and state status reports (dashboard data)

- a. Twice monthly in-person support status to CPDH for Safe Schools for All Hub
 - b. Monthly numbers of people on campus to County Office of Ed

- **Testing**

- Staff Testing monthly since Jan. 2021
- Investigating student testing option
- Community Testing: Feb. 6 event at Family Learning Ctr.

- **Tracking & Tracing**

- Daily Symptom Screener
 - Follow up on symptomatic and/or confirmed cases
 - Identify possible close contacts and/or exposures
 - Reporting cases
 - Santa Clara Public Health
 - COVID-19 Notifications
