Overview: Since Our Last Board Meeting

1. School site leadership teams continue finalizing site plans to support neediest students.
2. District team met with each principal to determine canopies placement, quarantine areas, classroom set up maps, placing marking for distancing reminders
3. Received updates on school reopening guidance from County Public Health
4. Attended the HVAC webinar from the Public Health Dept.
5. Signed contract to provide staff COVID testing at school/district sites
6. Met with District Fall Reopening Planning Committee on 10/20/20

Reopening Committee Recommendation

Members solicited and reported feedback from their representative groups on the two preferred schedules for Phase 2 instruction

AA/W/BB Schedule for Phase 2 in January 2021

- Consistency for teacher & parent planning
- Facilitates cleaning schedule
- Allows for teaching full concepts and targeted support (reading, math)
- Expanded Learning will be more able to provide childcare on non instruction day for families

Preparation for Phase 2

- Schools/Faculty will determine daily/weekly scheduling within the parameters of the Phase 2 schedule
 - Content best suited for synchronous/asynchronous days
 - Support for students viewing in-person instruction remotely, combo classes, etc.
- Finalized communication tools for staff, students and families
 - Parent Handbook on Reopening
 - Slides/Videos explaining all safety protocols to be presented to all staff by supervisors
 - Videos for students and families to see what to expect

More Schools Offer In-person Support

In addition to the programs reported Oct. 15, providing Learning Labs for a little more than 250 students...

- Castlemont: Learning lab supervised by Inst. Aides; in-office tech support for families
- Forest Hill: 2 SDC teachers; Specialized Learning Lab to start Nov. 9; Social skills groups with Behaviorists
- Lynhaven: Gr 3 instruction and speech support
- Marshall Lane: Specialized Learning Lab in planning
- Monroe: Small-group Learning Labs
- Rolling Hills: Learning labs for targeted 6th - 8th grade M,T,Th,F; SpED reading instruction and work completion support on Wednesdays
- Rosemary: a teacher supporting small group in-person during regular remote lessons
- Sherman Oaks: Added 4th Grade Reading and ELD labs, and TK-1st *Español con los directores*
