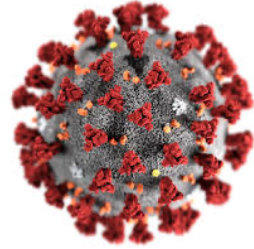

Current Status



- ▶ Stay Home Order enacted by SCCoPHD until January 4
 - ▶ We will not be moving to Phase 2 until two weeks of remaining in Red Tier (Substantial)
 - ▶ Based on current county status, the earliest we would be moving to Phase 2 would be Jan. 19, 2020 (1/18 is MLK day)
 - ▶ All programs currently open remain open

Communication in Place



- ▶ **Weekly messages related to reopening posted on district and school websites.**
 - ▶ COVID Exposure Control Plan has been shared with all staff
 - ▶ Site-specific plans and procedures have been shared with staff
 - ▶ Parent COVID-19 Handbooks have been completed for all sites
 - ▶ Parent meeting being held to review the information
 - ▶ Sites developing **slides**/videos to support messaging
 - ▶ Parents have received and are returning signed commitment to conduct daily symptom screening
 - ▶ School sites have a **Reopening Plan** link on their webpage with related documents, presentations, schedules and all COVID related information
 - ▶ A link to each school's Reopening Plan web page has been added to District COVID page

In-Person Phase 2 Readiness

- ▶ Teachers are confirming all PPE and hygiene materials in classrooms
 - ▶ Ensuring classrooms are set up for distancing requirements
 - ▶ Sites determined students to be on A or B hybrid cohort
 - ▶ Parents informed on 12/9
 - ▶ Finalizing asynchronous **teaching-and-learning** model

Testing, Tracking and Tracing

- ▶ We have a robust process for tracking and tracing positive cases and close contacts
 - ▶ HR department manages staff notification and procedures
 - ▶ Nurses manage students' notification and procedures
- ▶ Testing for Staff **by Curative**
 - ▶ Smaller trial run before Winter Break
 - ▶ Begin testing staff at sites week of January 4
