Community Liaisons

- District provides CLs at all sites
- Measure A funds 1.0 - Rosemary & CMS
- All Title One sites 0.75 FTE, Non Title One 0.375 FTE
 - Supporting chronic absenteeism
 - Supporting families by addressing barriers to attendance
 - Connecting with community resources
 - Calling the families who have shown improvement

Blackford: 8 of the 32 chronic absentees from last year have not missed a day of school. 10 have missed less than 3 days in the first 45 days.
